The 2024/2025 school year is officially back in session! We welcomed 86 students to campus in early September, filling our four classrooms from preschool to 5th grade.

Over the summer months, turned our attention to campus improvements in preparation for the school year and our 50th anniversary celebration on April 5, 2025. Among the improvements were a new roof on the Red Door and Music Room building, and new beautiful signs that went up at the staff parking entry, the main parking lot entry and, most notably, at the entrance to school.
